WWNA Needs You

We are looking for volunteers to circulate petitions asking OKC to install additional streetlights and/or traffic signs in our neighborhood. We feel that the addition of these lights/signs will improve the safety of our neighborhood.

The petitions for the *street lights* have to be signed by the neighbors within 300 feet of the proposed location. We have indicated the proposed location on maps attached to the petitions. We are considering the average lot size to be 60' so we need volunteers to petition the 8 houses on each side of the proposed location. We will need to inform the homeowners at the proposed locations that a decorative street light could possibly be installed within the city's easement in their yard.

The petitions for the *traffic signs* have to be signed by the neighbors within 300 feet of the proposed location. We are considering the average lot size to be 60' so we will need to petition the 8 houses closest to the location of the proposed sign. Please petition both sides of the street, on the first street listed on the petition. In order to simplify the petition process and not overlap any addresses, we will have different teams cover the intersecting streets. For example, we are asking for a stop sign at the corner of Harvest Trail & 4th. Wonderful volunteer team 1 will petition Harvest Trail and Wonderful volunteer team 2 will petition SW 4th.

If you are willing to help us with this project please call Paula Roberts at 408-8172. We will have the petitions at our next WWNA meeting on January 15, 2009. We hope to have the petitions ready to turn in Oklahoma City by April 1st.
